Louis Thibierge is a Paris-based independent arbitrator with more than twenty years' experience in international arbitration and complex cross-border commercial disputes. He sits as sole arbitrator, co-arbitrator and tribunal president in ICC, CMAP, Chambre arbitrale de Paris and ad hoc proceedings. His practice spans construction, corporate, energy, defence, industrial, distribution and media disputes. A Full Professor of Private Law (Agrége des Facultés de Droit) at Aix-Marseille University, where he heads the Department of Private Law and Criminal Sciences, he combines academic authority with extensive practice as former Senior Counsel and Avocat à la Cour in leading international law firms. He regularly acts as an expert on French law before foreign courts and arbitral tribunals, and is a qualified English-language translator: he pleads, drafts and deliberates in English.
